The Registrant's Form 10-Q, when filed, will report an unaudited consolidated net loss of approximately \$7.1 million for the three months ended September 30, 1999, compared to an unaudited consolidated net loss of approximately \$3.2 million for the three months ended September 30, 1998. The loss for the three months ended September 30, 1999, from recurring operations, exclusive of the following, is expected to be approximately \$6.2 million. For the three months ended September 30, 1999, the Registrant will also recognize a loss of approximately \$.9 million relating to lower of cost or market write-down on inventory related to the Chemical Business' nitrate-based products and a loss related to the Chemical Business' firm purchase commitment of ammonia, which contract has an adverse pricing formula under the present market conditions.
